Continued to discuss boiler issues. Mike got a quote of \$ 6845 to repair the cracked boiler, with an additional \$1500 if the part is not warranted. Now that we do not need heat, we can do repairs w/e 4/24 or 5/1.

Discussed the fellowship hall pipe. Roger Schweitzer Co. gave quote of \$ 1300 to remove pipe, although a few trustees feel that we can remove if the pipe is a straight shot. John made a point that we could remove, but it should be left to professionals to replace because of the threading needed to put together pieces. Mike spoke with Roto-Rooter, and they think they can put a camera down the condensate pipe to review damage and make a determination of repair needed.(Mike is meeting them at church on 4/22)

Mike read letter from Finance team on any expenditures of over \$200 need treasurer approval.

Steeple issue needs to remain on our list. No monies to repair, but we need to keep thinking about this.

Van Committee report from Patrick---first meeting will be 4/22. Patrick will report at our next meeting.

Rumpke has sent us a quote for dumpster trash removal. It may be cheaper than CSI, and Linda will check with Nancy on CSI charge.

May 4th voters will use fellowship hall for primary election. Patrick and John to set up on Sunday 5/2.

Tim Crowe from SPRC has requested trustee representation at custodian interviews. Mike & Jim will do.

Marty and Gwen have requested to remove the brick flower bed on the north steps. Brick is deteriorating and it is difficult to take care of. Motion made and passed. Ray K. to do removal. Ray has also repaired the grates in the front parking lot.

Discussed maroon mats on first floor. The condensation from rubber mats has caused tiles to be removed. Linda checked with ReStore and they do not have tiles. She will check with Lowes and HomeDepot.
